Every year, our Annual Report provides an opportunity to share with you highlights and stories from the Chamber. It has been an honor and a privilege to serve as President of the Argentina-Texas Chamber of Commerce for the 2021-2022 period.

We have had another challenging year. I assumed the presidency of the chamber during unprecedent times. The pandemic and its transformations have made us rethink our actions and projects, and the way we support business between Texas and Argentina.

We learned how to overcome the pandemic challenges by taking advantage of new technologies to support the interaction and relationship between chapters and committees, directors, and members during this past year. Teamwork was crucial to the accomplishment of our goals.

In November, ATCC had its first in-person gathering to celebrate its 5th anniversary. Since then, we have transitioned to a hybrid way of building our relationships. We continued organizing large events, such as the OTC trade mission that will take place in May 2022. On the other hand, we continued working online and generating attractive proposals for our members.

We generated opportunities for our members and conducted more than 26 webinars series and shared 12 newsletters. Our top webinars include, the Internationalization Program for Small and Medium Businesses, 2022 Energy Program, Technology Pitches, Best Practices Round Table, Get to Know Our Members, and Meet and Greet events for new members, among others.

Our membership increased to 150 members in 2021, adding new members and sponsors across all business sectors. Our focus during 2021 was to expand our services and their value. We achieved that by building a stronger Chamber, strengthening our presence with five geographic chapters and five business sectors.

Our chapters include Buenos Aires and Patagonia in Argentina and Houston, Dallas, and Austin in Texas. We continued working and developing our business sectors: Energy and Engineering, Technology and Innovation, Healthcare and Biotechnology, Food and Beverages, and Real Estate committees.

In 2022, we were able to hire an Operations Manager to handle the day-to-day operations allowing ATCC the capabilities to provide more activities relevant to the demands of our members.


